St. Vincent de Paul had some conversion to be a saint, he notes: “As a young man, when my father took me to the city, I was ashamed of going with him and of recognizing him as my father because he went poorly dressed and limped. I refused to go out and see him. “ His father died when Vincent was 17, and he converted in such a way that Vincent de Paul is now known for his love and care for the poor.
